USDA Broadband Technical Assistance (BTA)

Funding Amount

\$20 Million technical assistance funds authorized for USDA ReConnect by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)

- \$7.5 million for Technical Assistance Providers – Min award: \$50,000 Max award: \$1 million
- \$7.5 million for Technical Assistance Recipients – Min award: \$50,000 Max award: \$250,000
- \$5 million for projects supporting cooperatives – Min award: \$50,000 Max award: \$1 million

BTA is funded through a cooperative agreement and requires substantial involvement from the awarding agency (USDA RUS)

Eligible Applicants

- Federally-recognized Tribes and Tribal entities
- State or local governments, including agencies and subdivisions, among others
- Territories or possessions of the United States
- Institutions of higher education (including 1862 Land-Grant Institutions, 1890 Land-Grant Institutions, 1994 Land-Grant Institutions, Hispanic-Serving Institutions, and Historically Black Colleges and Universities)
- Nonprofit organizations with 501(c)(3) IRS status
- Cooperatives or mutual organizations
- Corporations
- Limited Liability Companies or Limited Liability Partnerships

Eligible Projects

- Project must promote broadband expansion to a rural community, including:
 - Helping recipients identify broadband resources and planning for delivering broadband
 - Identifying public and private resources to finance broadband facilities
 - Preparing studies, reports, and surveys necessary to support broadband services, or to request financial assistance to develop broadband facilities
 - Improving broadband facilities management and operations
- No cost sharing or match requirement

Eligible Areas

- Targeted communities:
 - Tribes and Tribal entities
 - Colonia areas
 - Persistent poverty counties
 - Distressed energy communities
- A rural area is defined as:
 - Any area not located in a city, town, or incorporated area with a population greater than 20,000
 - An urbanized area next to a city, town or incorporated area with a population greater than 50,000
- Must be completely contained within a rural area or composed of multiple rural areas

Evaluation Criteria

- Work Plan – 30 points
- Organizational Capacity – 20 points
- Targeted Communities – 20 points
- Rurality – 20 points
- Economic Need – 20 points
- Performance Measures – 10 points
