## Funding Amount: **\$980,000,000**

### Program Details

**Program Name:** Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program (TBCP) Round 2

**Administrator:** National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA)

**Authorizing Legislation:** American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

### Funding Details

- **Broadband Infrastructure Deployment**
  - \$1,000,000 minimum
  - \$50,000,000 maximum
- **Broadband Use and Adoption**
  - \$100,000 minimum
  - \$2,500,000 maximum
- **Match Requirement:** No match required

### Key Dates

- **January 23, 2024 – Application Window Closes (11:59 p.m. ET)**
- April 22, 2024 – Anticipated announcement date
- May 6, 2024 – Earliest start date for awarded projects
- **Projects must be completed within 4 years of project award**

### Eligible Costs

- Eligible Costs Specific to Broadband Infrastructure Deployment, see NOFA pg 38-39
- Eligible Costs Specific to Broadband Adoption and Use, See NOFA pg 39
- SF-242A Detailed Budget Justification spreadsheet
- Indirect costs and administrative costs, not to exceed 2% of requested grant amount
- Broadband Infrastructure Deployment projects planning, feasibility, and sustainability studies, not to exceed 2.5% (does not count toward the 2% of indirect costs)

## Eligible Projects

- Broadband infrastructure deployment projects (Tribal Consent and Authorization required)
  - including support of carrier-neutral submarine cable landing stations
- Affordable broadband programs
  - Providing free or reduced cost broadband
  - Preventing disconnection of existing broadband service
- Distance learning
- Telehealth
- Digital inclusion efforts (including digital equity planning and workforce activities)
- Broadband adoption activities

## Scoring Criteria

### **Broadband Use and Adoption Projects:** 100 Total Points Available

- Public Purpose and Benefits – **up to 40 points**
- Project Viability – **up to 30 points**
- Project Budget and Capacity Building- **up to 30 points**

### **Broadband Infrastructure Deployment Projects:** 100 Total Points Available

- Project Purpose and Benefits - **up to 45 points**
- Project Viability - **up to 30 points**
- Project Budget and Sustainability - **up to 25 points**

Based on an average of the reviewer's scores, applications will be assigned a rating of qualified or unqualified for funding for each priority grouping in accordance with the following:

Qualified for Funding: 70 - 100 points

Unqualified for Funding: 0 – 69 points
