**RUS Community Connect Grant**

## Funding Amount

Up to \$79 million for Fiscal Year 2023

- Awards up to \$5 million per project
- Matching funds of at least 15% from non-federal sources are required

## Key Dates

- **March 20** – Application Period Opens
- **June 20 – Application Period Closes at 11:59 AM ET**
- **September** – Anticipated Award Date

## Eligible Applicants

- State and Local Governments
- Federally Recognized Tribes
- Cooperatives
- Nonprofits
- For-profit Corporations
- Limited Liability Companies

## Eligible Areas

- Rural areas lacking broadband speed of at least 25/3 Mbps are eligible

## Eligible Projects

- Upon completion, must deliver service of 100/20 Mbps
- Must offer free service at 100/20 Mbps to all participating Essential Community Facilities within the PFSA for at least 2 years
- Must provide a Community Center within the PFSA with a minimum of 2, and up to 10, computer access points and wireless access at 100/20 Mbps, free of charge, to all users for at least 2 years

## Selection Criteria

- Community Needs Category – up to 50 points
- Stakeholder Involvement Category – up to 40 points
- Experience Category – up to 10 points
- In making a final selection between applications with comparable rankings and geographic distribution, the Administrator may take into consideration the following characteristics:
  - Persistent poverty counties served within the PFSA
  - Out-migration Communities served within the PFSA
  - Speed of service provided
  - Substantially Underserved Trust Areas served within the PFSA
  - Community members with disabilities served within the PFSA
  - Any other additional factors outlined in the FOA, program application guide, and program website

- Effective Grant Writing
- Track Record of Success

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## Eligible Costs

- Construction, acquisition, or leasing of facilities, spectrum, land, or buildings used to deploy broadband service
- Cost of providing broadband service free of charge to the critical community facilities for 2 years
- Less than 10% of the grant amount or up to \$150,000 may be used for the improvement, expansion, construction or acquisition of a community center that provides online access to the public
- Matching funds can be used for operating costs

## Ineligible Costs

- Operating expenses
