**USDA Rural Energy for America (REAP) Technical Assistance Grant Program**

## **Background**

**Administrator:** US Department of Agriculture (USDA)

**Authorizing Legislation:** Inflation Reduction Act

**Purpose:** Enable applicants to provide technical assistance to Agricultural Producers and Rural Small Businesses applying to REAP

**Award:** Maximum of \$500,000/minimum of \$100,000 per applicant, no match required

## **Key Dates**

- **August 10** – Last day to request technical assistance or application guidance
- **August 15 – Application Submission Deadline**
- **September 30** – Award Date

## **Eligible Applicants**

- Units of State, Tribal, or local government
- Land-grant colleges or universities, or other Institutions of Higher Education
- Electric cooperatives
- Public Power Entities
- Investor-owned utilities
- Councils as defined under the Resource Conservation and Development Program (16 U.S.C. 3451)
- Not-for-profit entities
- For-profit entities
- Sole proprietor businesses
- Other business entities

## **Eligible Activities**

Activities must be directly related to providing technical assistance to Agricultural Producers or Rural Small Businesses to apply for assistance under REAP. These may include, but are not limited to:

- Providing information on how to improve energy efficiency and/or how to use Renewable Energy technologies and resources
- Conducting and promoting Energy Assessments and audits as defined in 7 CFR 4280.103
- Preparing a technical report in accordance with 7 CFR 4280.110(g)
- Assisting with filing for System Award Management (SAM) and Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) registrations
- Assisting with completing a REAP grant application in accordance with 7 CFR 4280.116
- Assisting with planning construction and development in accordance with 7 CFR 4280.125

- Assisting with completion of environmental reports and/or documentation required for submittal of applications

## Selection Criteria

- Applicants must score at least 40 points to be considered
- Priority will be given to applicants:
  - Assisting distressed/disadvantaged communities
  - Pursuing projects using underutilized technologies
  - Pursuing projects under \$20,000

## Scoring Criteria

Scoring (maximum of 100 points):

- Experience implementing successful technical assistance programs – **up to 20 points**
- Soundness of approach – **up to 30 points**
- Recruitment of Priority REAP Projects – **up to 20 points**
- Performance measures – **up to 10 points**
- State Director discretionary points – **up to 20 points**
