- Nonprofit Organizations
- Local Governments

Allowable Challenges

- Service availability
 - Speed
 - Latency
 - Data cap
 - Technology
 - Business service only
 - Enforceable Commitments
 - **Planned Service (deployed by June 30, 2024)**
- ❖ Speed tests will be collected from individuals to be submitted by an eligible challenger in order to determine eligibility
